Short Dialogues with Verbs +는 (present tense)

- (At a bus stop)
- A: 여기 인천국제공항 가는 버스 서요?
B: 네, 서요.

Does the bus to Incheon International Airport stop here (Lit. bus that goes to Incheon International Airport)?
 - A: 너 어떤 스타일의 남자가 좋아?
B: 키 크고 거짓말 안 하는 남자.
 넌 어떤 여자가 좋아?
A: 난 음식 잘하는 여자가 좋아.

What kind of guy do you like?
Tall guys who don't lie.
What about you?
I like girls that can cook well.
 - A: 야, 아까 너랑 얘기한 남자 누구야?
B: 어, 그냥 아는 오빠야.

Who's the guy that was talking to you a while ago?
Uh, he's just a guy I know.
 - A: 야, 아까 너랑 얘기한 여자 누구야?
B: 어, 그냥 아는 동생이야.

Who's the girl that was talking to you a while ago?
Uh, she's just an acquaintance.
 - A: 내가 좋은 여자 하나 소개시켜 줄까?
B: 나 만나는 여자 있어.

Do you want me to hook you up with a nice girl?
I'm seeing someone.
 - A: 모르는 거 있으면 뭐든지 물어봐.
B: 알았어. 고마워.

Ask me anything if you need to (Lit. If there's something you don't know, ask me anything).
 - A: 너 음식 뭐 좋아해?
B: 난, 다 좋아해.
A: 특히 좋아하는 거?
B: 떡볶이.
A: 그럼, 싫어하는 음식은?
B: 싫어하는 건 없어.

What food do you like?
I like all of them.
Which you like best (Lit. in particular)?
Tteokbokki.
Then, is there anything you don't like?
No, there isn't.
 - A: 시내에 비빔밥 잘하는 데 있어?
B: 비빔밥 잘하는 데?

Is there a good bibimbap restaurant in the city (Lit. Is there a place which is good at bibimbap)?

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9. A: 초콜릿 나도 좀 줘. Give me some of your chocolate.
B: 안 돼. 이거 백화점에서만 파는 거야. No. This is available only from a department store. This is expensive.
비싼 거야.
10. A: 어디 가냐? Uh, I'm on my way home (Lit. way/road that goes home).
B: 어, 집에 가는 길이야.

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Short Dialogues with Verbs +{을/ㄹ} (future tense)

1. A: 야, 빨리 일어나.
학교 갈 시간이야.
B: 아이, 5 분만 더 잘게요.
Hey, get up now (Lit. quickly). It's time to go to school.
Augh... let me sleep just five more minutes.
2. A: 지금 몇 시야?
B: 여덟 시 반.
A: 어, 한국영화 할 시간이야.
텔레비 좀 켜 봐.
What's the time now?
Half past eight.
Oh, there's a Korean film on soon (Lit. Oh, it will be time for a Korean film). Switch on the TV.
3. (On the phone)
A: 할 얘기가 있는데 잠깐 좀 만나.
B: 무슨 얘인데? 지금 그냥 해.
I need to talk to you (Lit. I have something to say to you). Can I meet you? (Lit. Let's meet for a moment.)
What's it about? Let's just talk now.
4. A: 여긴 웬일이야?
B: 근처에 볼 일이 좀 있어서.
What're you doing here?
I've got something to do nearby.
5. A: 오늘 할 일 많아?
B: 아니, 별로 없어.
Do you have lots of things to do?
No, not much.
6. A: 집에 먹을 게 하나도 없는데.
B: 그래? 그럼 밖에 나가서 먹을까?
We've got nothing to eat at home.
Yeah? Then, shall we eat out?
7. A: 나랑 같이 갈 사람?
B: 내가 같이 갈게.
Who's going to come with me (Lit. (Is there) anyone who's going to come with me)?
I'll come with you.
8. A: 너랑 지금 얘기할 시간 없어.
나중에 내가 전화할게.
B: 알았어. 그럼, 전화해 줘.
I've got no time to talk to you. I'll call you later.
Alright. Give me a call.
9. A: 마실 거 좀 줄까?
B: 마실 거? 뭐 있는데?
Do you want something to drink?
Drink? What have you got?
10. (On-train announcement)
이번 역은 시청, 시청 역입니다.
내리실 문은 왼쪽입니다.
Arriving at Sicheong (City Hall) Station (Lit. This stop is City Hall Station). Use left doors to get off (Lit. The doors to get off are on your left).
